

POVERTY ALLEVIATION PROGRAMMES:

There are 103 slums in the Nabadwip Municipality having 49,321 populations as per the Census India 2001 and now the population is 58,275 having 9931 families. More than 42% of the population of Nabadwip is living in Slums. Slums are located along the River Bhagirathi, inside the Railway Lines and also few in the heat of the city. Due to ineffective development control regulation Slums have developed on the riverbeds and also in the railway lands resulting into degrading Urban Development and unhealthy living conditions. Nabadwip Municipality has taken numbers of developmental activities under various Govt. Project to upgrade their living standards and various self employment programme for betterment of their living condition.

The Centrally Sponsored and State Sponsored Programmes like National Slum Development Programme (NSDP), Integrated Low Cost Sanitation Scheme (ILCS), IHSDP project under JNNURM, SJSRY, CBPHCS are in operation for Slum improvement in Nabadwip City.
